



Art Competition Terms and Conditions

By entering SASA's Art Competition and submitting one or more designs you agree to the following:

- My submission(s) are of my own original artwork and not that of any other artist.
- I understand that if it is discovered that one or more of my submission(s) is NOT of my own creation I will be immediately disqualified from the competition.
- My submitted artwork is now the property of SASA. SASA reserves the right to use said artwork for designs including but not limited to merchandising on the Bazaar and promotional purposes as a compilation highlighting entries on the website. SASA will credit the original artist (you) within the item description of merchandise on the Bazaar and other instances where your design is utilized if at all feasible. SASA reserves the right to make minor modifications to the original artwork including but not limited to embedding the SASA logo within the design, changing color(s) or any means necessary to display said design on 3-D products.
- Prize winners will be allotted an item of choice from the Bazaar and will receive a sticker as well. Both items will include one or more of your designs.
- SASA reserves the right to determine the number of winners subject to the quantity and quality of submissions.
- Design winners will be selected by a panel of judges assembled by SASA.
- If a design is selected as a winner, the artist will be responsible for creating various file sizes for use by SASA. Failure to do so within a reasonable amount of time may result in a rejection of a design as a winner. SASA will be responsible for

communicating the exact file sizes, dimensions, and SASA logo(s) to be integrated into the winning design(s).

- Notification of the winners will occur via email at a date TBD on or after August 2, 2021 but before August 16, 2021.
- The presence of winning artists is requested but not required at the formal announcement of winners during the Virtual Conference on August 15-16, 2021.
- Acceptance of these terms is not indicative of an on-going relationship with SASA, only a one-time transferral of rights to designs submitted solely to this competition. Artists retain the rights to all designs created independently of this competition. However, SASA reserves the right to approach artists who participate in this competition to pursue a formal design partnership if SASA leadership determines it would be beneficial to both parties.
